PASTORAL PLANNING UPDATE

As the implementation phase of the Pastoral Plan *Disciples in Mission* continues, Saint Paul Parish, Cambridge was in the original group of Phase 3 collaborative parishes to be initiated on June 2, 2015. Given the unique mission of this parish that also administers St. Paul's Choir School and the Harvard University Catholic Center, Cardinal Seán has decided that further study be engaged on how this community can best serve the vital work of *Disciples in Mission* within the Archdiocese. Therefore, Saint Paul will not participate in the current Phase 3 of *Disciples in Mission* with the expectation that it will become part of a future collaborative, as will be the case for all of the parishes in the Archdiocese.

CHRISTMAS CRÈCHE DISPLAY

You may have noticed that the Christmas Crèche remains displayed in the church following the official conclusion of the Christmas season. The crèche will remain until the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord on February 2nd. This practice is one that is observed in Rome and serves as powerful reminder of the gift of the Word made flesh – Jesus Christ – through His Incarnation at Christmas. As you gaze upon the images of Jesus, Mary and Joseph may you offer a prayer of thanksgiving for the gift of God's love for us all through the person and saving work of His Son, Jesus, our Divine Messiah.
