### THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION – CANDLEMAS DAY

#### Special Blessing of Candles – February 2, 2015

The Feast of the Presentation celebrates the day, forty days after Christ's birth, when Our Lord was presented in the Temple at Jerusalem in compliance with Jewish Law. As we read in the Gospel of St. Luke, a very holy and just man, Simeon, prayed over the Christ Child to fulfill the prophesy of the long-awaited Messiah's presence. The celebration of this feast dates to the earliest days of the Church and it marks the official close of the Christmas celebrations. From the eleventh century onward, candles to be used in the church have been blessed on this feast. **Following this tradition, there will be a special blessing of candles at both the 8:00 AM and 12.10 PM Masses on Monday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.** All parishioners are invited to bring candles from their homes that they plan to use on their dinner tables during the coming year to be blessed at this Mass.
