As you read this, I will either be in the air or have landed in Germany with our Choir School! I want to thank Fr. George and Fr. Patrick for taking on extra duties while I am away, and to the other priests who are coming to assist the parish.

Last week, we had almost 50 couple here for their Pre-Cana Marriage Preparation. For two days they had the chance to listen to many couples speak about marriage, with plenty of time for personal conversation, quiet, confession, Mass, and dance lessons! We are all grateful to the team for their many hours of preparing for this weekend and their commitment to the beauty of sacramental marriage.

We also want to pray for the undergrads who will be away on their Winter Retreat next week. A time with the Lord and one another in the midst of their busy and stressful lives is a great thing to do. With the theme of "Radical Joy" to focus them, I am sure that their time at the Franciscan Retreat House in Maine will be a blessed one.

Last weekend, we had our Annual 52/20 Pledge Cards available in the pews for those who would find it convenient to sign up or increase their contribution. FOOD PANTRY

One of the best things about the food pantry is hearing from customers how much the pantry helps them and how much they appreciate all of the volunteers and donors. We get to know our customers and their preferences rather than handing them a prepacked bag of items that they will never use (some even bring us unwanted items from other food pantries). Because we do not receive food from the Greater Boston Food Bank, we are not subject to the requirements and restrictions that limit their use of other food pantries. The current priority list includes coffee (regular, decaf, instant), flavored tea, cereal, oatmeal (instant packets and canisters of oats), shelf stable milk and almond milk, salad dressing, honey, dried fruit, and nuts.

**CORI RENEWAL TIME
PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN**

Per the Archdiocese of Boston, as part of serving in **ANY** ministry at St. Paul's, or any parish in the Archdiocese, Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) checks are obtained for all volunteers who minister to or have the potential for unmonitored access to children, youth, elderly or the disabled. CORI checks with a valid ID will take place before you start practicing your ministry. Recently, we learned that all volunteers are also required to **read and sign a Code of Ministerial Behavior and complete a VIRTUS, Protecting God's Children, training class.** We are still receiving more information regarding VIRTUS training. We will keep you updated once we have scheduled training dates.
