## TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends and Parishioners,

Fr. Kelly asked me to give you the weekly update this week, which I am happy to do. There are many things happening. First, on a somber note, we mourn the loss of a long-time parishioner of St. Paul's and friend to so many here, Chip Piatti. He was a daily attendee of the 12:10pm Mass, and as an architecture professor, wonderfully offered his talents "for the greater glory of God." He was a trusty advisor to the parish in all of our renovations over the past few years, including for the Chapel of the Women Doctors, all of the painting in church, and most recently in the design of the St. John Henry Newman icon hanging in the right transept. So whether you knew him personally or not, everyone at St. Paul's has been directly affected by his contributions here. Chip requested that donations in his memory be made to St. Paul's Choir School. *May he rest in peace.*

On a happier note, I was honored to administer the sacrament of Confirmation and First Holy Communion last Sunday to the final member of last year's RCIA cohort. We can now boast of a record 24 conversions in one year! Congratulations to Laura!

As we begin to mark the "Year of the Eucharist" in the Archdiocese of Boston, our committee at St. Paul's has been planning several initiatives, including opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration. We will now have exposition in the main church every Friday, 11:00am-noon. In addition, we're looking forward to an overnight vigil of adoration, beginning Friday October 30 at 1:00pm and ending on Saturday the 31st at 9:00am. We hope that everyone will consider signing up for a one-hour slot so that we'll have 4 people praying in the church throughout the entire vigil.

It's hard to imagine that with the undergraduate students - mostly freshmen - leaving campus before Thanksgiving, they will only be here for 5 more weeks. Naturally, outreach has been challenging with the limitations presented to us, however, the lack of things happening on campus has actually provided an opportunity to connect with more freshmen than usual. A handful are even planning on receiving Baptism and Confirmation before they leave! Looking ahead, I am pleased to welcome back to the Catholic Center an alumna of Harvard and member of the Sisters of Life, Sr. Hope. She will be leading my undergraduate virtual retreat on Saturday.

**YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST**

Blessed Carlo Acutis was beatified last Saturday. The late fifteen-year-old Italian was recalled by Pope Francis to be "a young man in love with the Eucharist." Indeed, during his life, Carlo created a website devoted to Eucharistic miracles ([www.miracolieucaistici.org](http://www.miracolieucaistici.org)). Carlo once said, "The more Eucharist we receive, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven." Like Carlo, may we have a desire to frequently adore the Eucharist and receive Holy Communion.
